DETAILED INFORMATION - OUT OF SCHOOL SPORT

1. RIPPA RUGBY run by BOP Rugby Union

Rippa Rugby is a fast moving game that is fun and simple to play. It's great for those who don't play rugby, as it is non-contact, and for those who do play rugby, a good game for some pre-season training and keep your skills and fitness up. Please keep in mind that TPS enters a Year 3/4 and a Year 5/6 Rippa Rugby Team in the WBOP Rippa Rugby World Cup in Term 2. These teams require 5 girls with 3 on the field at all times, so it would be great to see lots of girls playing. Playing in Term 1 will provide the opportunity for all players to improve their skills before these teams are selected.

Who can play: Years 1-6 boys and girls

Where: Waipuna Park, Welcome Bay

Dates: Thursday 22nd February to Thursday 28th April

Times: Games are played between 4:00pm and 6:00pm (30 minute games)

Cost: \$10.50

Uniform: School shorts and a school PE top (to be purchased from the school office for \$26.50)

Parent help: Referees are provided by the BOP Rugby Union, but each team will need a parent helper(s) to run the substitutes at each game.

2. FLIPPABALL run by Tauranga Waterpolo

Flippaball is a fantastic summer sport!! It is a modified version of water polo that provides the opportunity to develop the basic skills of passing and catching, water confidence and swimming skills.

Who can play: Year 3-6 boys and girls

Where: Memorial Pool (Year 3&4s in the learners pool and Year 5&6s in the 25m pool)

Dates: Tuesday nights starting on Tuesday 13th February to Tuesday 3rd April

Times: Games are played between the following times (2 x 10 minute halves):

Year 3&4s: 3:30 – 7:30pm

Year 5&6s: 4:00pm - 8:30pm

Cost: \$50 (includes pool entry each week)

Uniform: Any swimwear. Flippaball caps are provided.

Parent helpers: Teams will need a parent helper(s) to run the substitutes. Umpires are provided.

Weekly Draw: Can be found on the school sports notice board or on www.taurangawaterpolo.co.nz

3. Competitive Water Polo

This game will be played in deep water at the BOP Polytechnic pool against intermediate aged players. If your child is a confident swimmer and has previously played flippaball, this may be the sport for them!

Who can play: Year 5&6 boys and girls

Where: BOP Polytechnic pool

Dates: Friday nights starting on Friday 16th February and finishing on Friday 6th April. There will be no games on Good Friday the 30th March.

Times: Games are played between 4:00pm and 8:30pm (20 minute games – 5 minute quarters with no shot clock)

Cost: \$50 (includes pool entry each week)

Uniform: Appropriate swimwear (no baggy shorts or rash tops).

Parent help: Umpires are provided by the Tauranga Water Polo Association. Please note that the team will require a coach and/or manager.

4. KIWI VOLLEYBALL run by Tauranga Volleyball

(Please note that this sport has details still to be confirmed – will go live on School Shop once confirmed)

Kiwi Volleyball is a kid friendly version of the real thing, but with only 4 players on the court and lowered nets. Great for the development of the basic volleyball skills including serve, set and pass, and if you're up for it.... SPIKE!!!

Who can play: Year 3-6 boys and girls

Where: QEYC

Dates: Friday nights (TBC)

Times: Games are played at various times TBC (40 minute games)

Cost: TBC

Uniform: School shorts and a school PE top (can be borrowed from school or can be purchased from the school office for \$26.50)

Parent help: Teams will need a parent helper(s) to run the substitutes. Umpires are provided.

5. KIWITAG run by OTUMOETAI EELS RUGBY LEAGUE CLUB

Generally the same rules as Rippa Rugby, but a little Rugby League influence.

Who can play: Years 3-6 boys and girls

Where: Mitchell Park, Otumoetai

Dates: Monday evenings starting on Monday 12th February to 9th April

Times: Games are played at 4:40pm / 5:10pm / 5:50pm

Cost: \$20.50

Uniform: School shorts and school PE top (borrowed from school or can be purchased from the school office for \$26.50)

Parent help: Teams will need a parent helper(s) to run the substitutes, plus someone who is willing to referee.

Weekly draws: The draw can be found on the school sports noticeboard.

6. JUNIOR CRICKET run by WBOP Cricket Association

Cricket is a great game for so many fundamental skills including catching, throwing, bowling and running and of course teamwork.

Who can play: Years 1-6 boys and girls

Where: Various grounds around Tauranga and the WBOP

Dates: Saturday mornings starting on Saturday 10th February

Times: Year 1&2s 9-10:00am / Year 3&4s 9-11:30am / Year 5&6s 8:30-12:00pm

Cost: Year 1&2s \$20 / Year 3&4s \$25 / Year 5&6s \$30

Uniform: School shorts and school PE top (loaned from school or can be purchased from the school office for \$26.50)

Parent help: Teams will need a parent to help manage the team during games, plus someone able to score and umpire if necessary.
